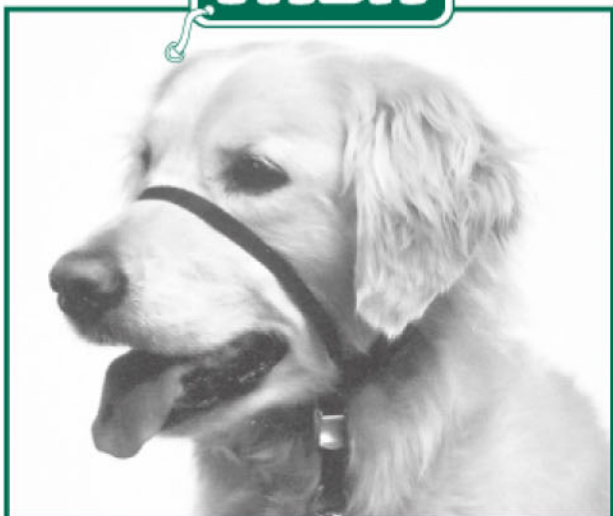

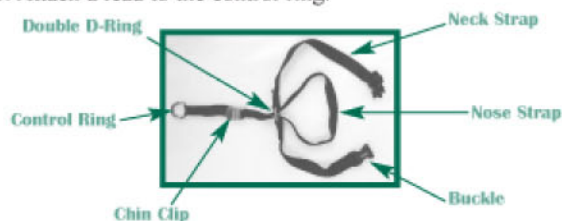

FITTING THE HEADCOLLAR

The headcollar may be used on puppies as young as eight to ten weeks of age. No dog is too old. It is recommended that the headcollar only be worn on the dog while it is being supervised. **A PROPER FIT IS ESSENTIAL FOR THE HEADCOLLAR TO WORK TO ITS MAXIMUM BENEFIT.** Read and follow the fitting instructions carefully, to ensure a proper fit.

1. Attach a lead to the control ring.



2. Open the neck strap holding the male end of the buckle in one hand and the female end of the buckle in the other. Draw tight so the nose loop and the attached lead hang down forming the letter "T".



3. Pre-fit the neck strap high around your dog's neck, just behind the ears and touching the back of the base of the skull. **THE NECK STRAP MUST BE SNUG SO THAT NOT EVEN ONE FINGER CAN FIT UNDER IT.** This prevents the neck strap from rotating around the neck, and allows the nose loop to be less restrictive and more comfortable.



4. Release the chin clip and slide it down to the control ring.

5. Pull the nose strap up through the Double-D ring.



6. With your dog at your side hold the nose loop open with the female end of the neck strap in one hand and the male end of the neck strap in the other. Reach under your dog's head and slide the nose loop over the dog's nose close to, but not touching the eyes.



7. Buckle the neck strap at its pre-fitted position, remembering it should be snug so that not even one finger can fit between the strap and neck. The proper fit of the nose loop is dependant upon the proper fit of the neck strap. Fit the neck strap first!

8. The nose strap should be in front of your dog's eyes and behind the corners of its mouth. **THE NOSE STRAP SHOULD BE LOOSE ENOUGH TO MOVE FORWARD TO THE FLESHY PART OF THE DOG'S NOSE, BUT NOT SO LOOSE THAT IT CAN BE PAWED OR PULLED OVER THE MUZZLE.** Adjust the nose clamp until the correct fit is obtained and snap it shut. Your dog will be able to pant, eat, drink, bark and play.



9. Once you have properly fitted the headcollar, cut off any excess length of the neck strap, seal the edge with a match or candle flame to prevent fraying.
